**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 98-094**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A STATE APPLICATION
FOR FEDERAL HIGHWAY FUNDS TO IMPROVE
THE DEEP CREEK BEACH ACCESS ROAD**


- WHEREAS,** the Deep Creek Beach Access Road has been in poor and unsafe condition for years and is in need of major work to provide safe access for both vehicles and pedestrians; and
- WHEREAS,** the Deep Creek Beach Access Road provides access to the Cook Inlet Beach from Ninilchik and is vital for both commerce and recreation within the borough;
- WHEREAS,** the Alaska Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation, the community of Ninilchik and the Ninilchik Native Association developed a mutually agreed upon consensus to improve the access and road, whereby the Native Association allows use of a portion of its property; and
- WHEREAS,** the Alaska Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation is submitting an application for a federal highway grant to improve the Deep Creek Beach Access Road; and
- WHEREAS,** Kenai Peninsula residents in the Ninilchik area have voiced their support for these road improvements, through their participation in public meetings with the Ninilchik Native Association and State Parks;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1.** The Kenai Peninsula Borough urges the Federal Highway Administration to grant a request by the Alaska Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation for funding to improve the Deep Creek Beach Access Road in order to provide safe and adequate access to the Cook Inlet Beach, the State Recreation Area, and commercial and traditional uses for both recreational visitors and commercial fishermen.
- SECTION 2.** A copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to Kenai Area Park Superintendent Chris Degernes, Alaska State Parks.


SECTION 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
