KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH RESOLUTION 99-008

A RESOLUTION CLASSIFYING THE WEST 132 FEET OF THE EAST 330 FEET OF GOVERNMENT LOT 6, SECTION 35, T1N, R1W, S.M., ALASKA, LYING SOUTH OF OLD NASH ROAD AS PRESERVATION, SAID PARCEL CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 0.91 ACRES

- WHEREAS, funds received by the Kenai Peninsula Borough from the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs were authorized to purchase subject parcel for flood mitigation purposes pursuant to KPB Ordinance 98-36; and
- WHEREAS, the borough has received Statutory Warranty Deed for the west 132 feet of the east 330 feet of Government Lot 6, Section 35, T1N, R1W, S.M., Alaska, lying south of Old Nash Road: and
- **WHEREAS,** in accordance with Chapter 17.10.080 public notice was published and notification was sent to land owners and/or leaseholders of record within one-half mile of the land proposed for classification, applicable agencies, and interested parties; and
- WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on the proposed classification December 14, 1998. The motion to recommend a classification of Preservation passed by a unanimous vote.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That borough land described as the west 132 feet of the east 330 feet of Government Lot 6, Section 35, T1N, R1W, S.M., Alaska, lying south of Old Nash Road, containing approximately 0.91 acres, be classified as Preservation.

SECTION 2. This classification shall take effect immediately upon adoption of this resolution.
