**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
RESOLUTION 99-058**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF SURPLUS ROOFING  
PROJECT FUNDS TO THE HOMER HIGH SCHOOL  
COLUMN ENCASEMENT PROJECT**

**WHEREAS,** the KPB assembly previously appropriated \$250,000 to identify, remove, and replace structurally unsound concrete block column enclosures at the Homer High School; and

**WHEREAS,** the identified enclosures also served as one and two hour fire rated encapsulations; and

**WHEREAS,** the Alaska State Fire Marshal agreed to allow continued occupation of the premises, with the understanding that a remedy was underway; and

**WHEREAS,** the project has incurred unanticipated engineering, architectural and construction costs associated with fire code compliance; and

**WHEREAS,** previously appropriated project funds totaling \$250,000 have been fully expended, but only about 50% of the work has been completed; and

**WHEREAS,** the unsound concrete block encasements represent a known safety hazard to users of the facility and must be corrected; and

**WHEREAS,** it is estimated that the project can be completed with additional funding of \$190,000; and

**WHEREAS,** bids for the Soldotna High School roof project were substantially lower than original estimates resulting in \$250,000 in surplus funds available for transfer;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is authorized to transfer \$190,000 from the Soldotna High School Roof project to the Homer High School Column Encasement Repair project.


**SECTION 2.** That the Mayor is authorized to increase current not-to-exceed amounts with the architect, engineer and construction contractors as needed to complete the repair work.
