**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE SOUTHEAST ALASKA GUIDANCE
ASSOCIATION'S ALASKA STATE PARKS GRANT APPLICATION FOR FUNDING
TRAIL CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE WORKSHOPS
FOR COMMUNITY VOLUNTEERS**

WHEREAS, The Kenai Peninsula Borough depends to a large extent upon volunteers for construction, maintenance, and management of community trails; and

WHEREAS, cooperation between agencies and community volunteers is important in improving the quality of our trails; and

WHEREAS, increasing the skill level of volunteers through training in design, layout, construction, and maintenance of trails will increase the comfort and enthusiasm of agencies in undertaking collaborative trail projects; and

WHEREAS, the Southeast Alaska Guidance Association is submitting a 2000 Recreational Trail Grant application for the purpose of providing Trail Construction and Maintenance Workshops in three boroughs in Alaska; and

WHEREAS, SAGA proposes to present a multi-day workshop in the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and


WHEREAS, the proposed workshops encourage and facilitate volunteer efforts to improve community trails in the Kenai Peninsula Borough and are consistent with Foal 9.1 of the KPB Trail Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough supports efforts of the Southeast Alaska Guidance Association to obtain a 2000 Recreational Trail Grant for the purpose of providing Trail Construction and Maintenance Workshops for trail volunteers.


SECTION 2. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough urges the Trails and Recreational Access for Alaska Board to fund this request.
