**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 99-089**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING ACCEPTANCE OF A GIFT OF LAND FROM THE
CITY OF KENAI FOR THE PURPOSE OF BUILDING A HEALTH CENTER**

WHEREAS, the Alaska Legislature appropriated \$1.7 Million to build a Health Center in Kenai based upon a joint use facility proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly adopted Resolution 98-066 supporting the Central Peninsula General Hospital's participation with the Alaska Department of Health and Social Services in the proposed joint use of a Public Health Center facility; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly enacted Ordinance 98-51 appropriating \$989,500 from the Central Peninsula Hospital Plant Expansion and Replacement Fund for design, construction, and furnishing of the Health Center; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kenai enacted City Ordinance 1796-98 dedicating Lot 2, Block 1 Etolin Subdivision, First Addition, Located at 630 Barnacle Way in Kenai as suitable for the public purpose of the construction of a Public Health Center; and

WHEREAS, the city of Kenai enacted Resolution No. 99-61 donating to the Borough Lot 2, Block 1 Etolin Subdivision, First Addition, located at 630 Barnacle Way in Kenai for the purpose of building a Kenai Peninsula Borough owned Public Health Center; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Planning Commission has reviewed and recommends the acquisition of this parcel;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to KPB 17.10.040, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly approves acceptance of the gift of land from the City of Kenai described as:

Lot 2, Block 1 EtoLin Subdivision, First Addition, Kenai Recording District, Third judicial District, State of Alaska, located at 630 Barnacle Way in Kenai,


to be used for the purpose of building a Kenai Peninsula Borough owned Public Health Center.

SECTION 2. The proposed classification of this land is commercial.


SECTION 3. That the mayor is authorized to execute any documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.
