RESOLUTION 2001-009 (MAYOR) SUBSTITUTE**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL
SERVICES TO ASSIST THE BOROUGH WITH THE PRISON PROJECT**

- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Ordinance 2000-59, the mayor has issued a request for qualifications seeking a firm or firms to provide qualifications and capability to participate in the planning, promotion, design, construction, and operation of an 800-1000 bed medium-security correctional facility; and
- WHEREAS,** professional assistance is needed by the borough to provide technical support to the RFQ evaluation committee, assistance with the development and negotiation of a contract, and optionally, assistance with the development of legislation; and
- WHEREAS,** the proposal submitted by Richard Crane was determined to be the most responsive to the borough's current needs; and
- WHEREAS,** upon enactment of ordinance 2000-19-20 adequate funds will be available to award this contract;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA
BOROUGH:**

- SECTION 1.** That the mayor is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract with Richard Crane for professional services relating to the prison project including without limitation providing technical support to the RFQ evaluation committee, providing the borough with assistance in developing and negotiating a contract with the selected firm, and providing assistance to the borough with the development of legislation.
- SECTION 2.** That the total amount of the contract shall be \$50,000.
- SECTION 3.** That all expenditures for this project will be charged to account number 100.94910.01PRN.43011.
- SECTION 4.** That this resolution takes effect immediately upon both passage of Ordinance 2000-19-20 and adoption of this resolution.
