**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 2001-017**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF TITLE AND OWNERSHIP OF
AN AMBULANCE TO THE NINILCHIK COMMUNITY AMBULANCE
ASSOCIATION, INC.**

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough was awarded a grant from the State of Alaska for the purpose of purchasing a safety vehicle for the community of Ninilchik; and

WHEREAS, through enactment of KPB Ordinance 99-52 the grant funds were accepted and appropriated; and

WHEREAS, the Ninilchik Community Ambulance Association, Inc. ("NCAA") is an Alaska nonprofit corporation providing emergency medical services to Ninilchik area residents; and

WHEREAS, the borough's purchasing officer and NCAA developed specifications for the vehicle; and

WHEREAS, on behalf of the NCAA, the borough solicited bids for this purchase; and

WHEREAS, through adoption of KPB Resolution 2000-055 the bid was awarded to H & W Emergency Vehicles; and

WHEREAS, upon receipt and acceptance of the ambulance, title will be given to the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, the borough wishes to transfer title, ownership, and responsibility of the vehicle to the NCAA in accordance with the purpose of the state grant award and in accordance with a cooperative agreement to be signed by both parties;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That upon receipt and acceptance of the ambulance from H & W Emergency Vehicles, title will be given to the Kenai Peninsula Borough.


SECTION 2. That once title to the vehicle is received by the borough, the mayor is authorized to transfer title of the ambulance to NCAA in accordance with the purpose of the state grant and the executed cooperative agreement which shall require that the ambulance be used for public purposes and in a manner consistent with the state grant requirements.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
