RESOLUTION 2001-068**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REAPPORTIONMENT COMMITTEE TO
CONSIDER SCHOOL BOARD DISTRICTING**

WHEREAS, the borough assembly has received the 2000 population figures from the U.S. Census Bureau, and Resolution 2001-040 authorized the assembly president to appoint a reapportionment committee to review assembly apportionment and develop one or more plans for assembly reapportionment for assembly consideration; and

WHEREAS, the school board is currently elected at large, and numerous people have expressed concern that the school board members should be elected by district to ensure balance borough-wide representation on the school board; and

WHEREAS, members of the reapportionment committee have expressed an interest in considering school board districting issues in addition to assembly reapportionment; and

WHEREAS, because the committee is becoming familiar with apportionment issues and is an appropriate body to consider in depth these related issues, the assembly finds that the borough's best interests would be served by allowing the reapportionment committee to consider this matter should it so choose;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the Reapportionment Committee appointed by Assembly President Navarre is authorized to consider school board districting in addition to the current authorization granted to it in Resolution 2001-040.


SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
