**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CENTRAL PENINSULA GENERAL HOSPITAL TO
PURCHASE TWO ACUSON ULTRASOUND UNITS**

WHEREAS, Central Peninsula General Hospital has completed a competitive process, and Acuson, a subsidiary of Siemens, has submitted the lowest bid; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the on-site clinical evaluations, and in an effort to standardize the medical imaging equipment, the hospital has recommended the purchase of the two ultrasound units; and

WHEREAS, both the CPGH Inc. Board of Directors and Service Area Board have approved the purchase of the ultrasound units; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of two new ultrasound units was approved in the FY02 Central Peninsula Hospital Service Area budget;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the assembly approves the purchase of the two ultrasound units which is not to exceed \$486,000.
