NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


- SECTION 1.** That in Assembly District 3, Gary Superman was elected to a 3-year term, having received the greatest number of votes cast.



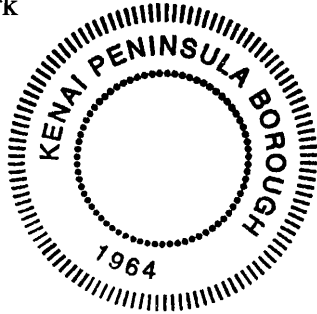
