**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 2001-115**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE STERLING SENIOR CENTER
PRE-DEVELOPMENT GRANT APPLICATION TO
ALASKA HOUSING FINANCE CORPORATION**

WHEREAS, the Sterling Senior Citizens Center obtained a \$20,000 Pre-Development Grant from the Alaska Housing Finance Corporation; and

WHEREAS, the Sterling Senior Citizens Center feels their immediate concern is housing and transportation for the senior population; and

WHEREAS, the market study has determined that the Sterling area can support senior housing; and

WHEREAS, the Sterling Senior Center has been serving the needs of the Sterling seniors for over 11 years and in 1998 completed a five year plan of operation which included lot utilization of property owned by the senior's for senior housing; and

WHEREAS, Sterling is one of the fastest growing communities on the Kenai Peninsula and the senior population is a factor in that growth;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly supports the efforts of the Sterling Senior Citizens Center to obtain grant funding for the purpose of building senior housing.

SECTION 2. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough urges the Alaska Housing Finance Corporation to fund this grant request.

SECTION 3. That a copy of the resolution shall be sent to Alaska Housing Finance Corporation; the Sterling Senior Center; Senators Lincoln, Torgerson and Ward; and Representatives Chenault, Morgan, Lancaster and Scalzi.


SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
