**WHEREAS,** the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly wishes to add its endorsement to these proposed projects;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**
