RESOLUTION 2001-119**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION TO THE ALASKA HISTORICAL
COMMISSION FOR THE COMMEMORATIVE NAMING OF AN UNNAMED PEAK
MT. ST. FLORIAN**

WHEREAS, Scott Walden, Chief, Kenai Fire Department, has submitted a request to the Alaska Historical Commission to name an unnamed peak eight miles east of Redoubt Volcano in commemoration of firefighters; and

WHEREAS, St. Florian is the considered the patron saint of firefighters worldwide; and

WHEREAS, Chief Walden provided a statement of support from the Kenai Firefighters Association; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission reviewed the application on October 22, 2001 and recommended approval of the proposed name by unanimous consent.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. The Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly supports the request of Chief Walden to name the unnamed peak Mt. St. Florian in commemoration of firefighters worldwide.


