## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH RESOLUTION 2001-128

## A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE STATE SENATE TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING IN SOLDOTNA, ALASKA REGARDING HIGHWAY RIGHT-OF-WAY ENCROACHMENTS

- WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT/PF) recently upgraded that portion of the Sterling Highway located in Soldotna; and
- WHEREAS, since completing the project, numerous right-of-way (ROW) encroachment issues have developed as DOT/PF prepares to close the project; and
- WHEREAS, KPB Resolution 2001-116, requesting DOT/PF to coordinate with the City of Soldotna to resolve ROW issues, passed unanimously on October 23, 2001; and
- WHEREAS, on November 14, 2001, the Soldotna City Council held a work session in which DOT/PF representatives presented information on the history of ROW dedications in Soldotna from before statehood and continuing through the subsequent formation of the borough and the City of Soldotna; and
- WHEREAS, this history of ROW dedications through Soldotna resulted in ROWs of varying widths on neighboring parcels and in some cases, ambiguity regarding the size of dedicated ROWs; and
- WHEREAS, these encroachment issues are not unique to Soldotna and may also be issues throughout the borough and the state;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly requests the Alaska State Senate Transportation Committee to hold a public hearing in Soldotna, Alaska on rightof-way encroachment issues affecting properties in the Kenai Peninsula Borough.
- **SECTION 2.** That a copy of this resolution be sent to Senator Cowdery, chair of the Senate Transportation Committee; Senators Torgerson, Ward, and Lincoln; Representative Foster, Chair of the House Transportation and Public Facilities Commission, Representatives Chenault, Scalzi, Lancaster, and Morgan; and Commissioner Perkins, Commissioner of DOT&PF.
- **SECTION 3.** That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
