**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 2001-113**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE FUNNY RIVER EMERGENCY SERVICES, INC.
FY 2002 MINI-GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE DENALI COMMISSION AND
USDA FOREST SERVICE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,000**

WHEREAS, Funny River Emergency Services, Inc. ("FRES Inc.") is a private nonprofit 501(c)(3) corporation, incorporated on June 1, 1999, for the primary purpose of providing fire protection, but also to improve other emergency services in the Funny River area; and

WHEREAS, the area served by FRES Inc. includes approximately 7,500 acres lying between the Kenai River, the Killey River, and the Funny River; and

WHEREAS, FRES Inc. purchased land on Funny River Road to support its operation, and it recently received a fire engine donated by Tesoro, and now needs to construct a building to house the fire engine; and

WHEREAS, last year FRES Inc. received a \$30,000 mini-grant from the Denali Commission and USDA Forest Service, which the assembly supported in Resolution 2000-076; and

WHEREAS, FRES Inc. is in the process of applying for a fiscal year 2002 mini-grant from the Denali Commission and USDA Forest Service in the amount of \$30,000 to assist in construction of a fire station and disaster relief facility in the Funny River area; and

WHEREAS, the grant application provides that the applicant should receive support from the local governmental entity with jurisdiction over the area within which they operate; and

WHEREAS, FRES Inc. operates within the Kenai Peninsula Borough and outside of any cities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly supports Funny River Emergency Services, Inc. in its efforts to obtain a FY 2002 mini-grant from the Denali Commission and the USDA Forest Service. The grant will be administered by the Alaska Department of Community and Economic Development in the amount of \$30,000 for assistance to help further the construction of the fire station and disaster relief facility.


SECTION 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.
