A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR THE NANWALEK SCHOOL FINAL CLEANUP ACTION TO THE NANWALEK IRA COUNCIL

- WHEREAS, the administration solicited and received proposals for the final cleanup, remediation, and excavation of contaminated soils at Nanwalek and, as all submitted bids exceeded the budget amount, the mayor rejected all bids; and
- WHEREAS, the Nanwalek IRA Council has since proposed to perform the work required under the Nanwalek School Final Cleanup Action Remediation and Excavation Services Bid and the Professional Services Proposal using a different approach than was described in the initial request for proposals; and
- **WHEREAS,** acceptance of this proposal will result in a savings of approximately \$37,749 over the lowest bid; and
- WHEREAS, acceptance of this proposal will also benefit the local community through employment and construction of a paved parking lot at the Nanwalek Health Clinic and Elder Care Facility; and
- WHEREAS, KPB 5.28.330 allows the borough to enter into a procurement agreement with a municipal government outside of the normal procurement procedures when it is in the best interest of the borough to do so; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Nanwalek IRA Council is recognized by the federal government as the tribal government for the Native Village of Nanwalek; and
- WHEREAS, the financial savings as well as the benefit to the local community make acceptance of this proposal in the best interest of the borough; and
- WHEREAS, funds are available for this project in account 250.21210.02NAN;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is authorized to enter into a government-to-government contract with the Nanwalek IRA Council to perform the required services for the not-to-exceed amount of \$161,651.

SECTION 2. Expenditures for the project will be charged to account 250.21210.02NAN.

SECTION 3. The mayor is authorized to execute all documents and make all agreements deemed necessary to complete this project in accordance with this resolution and the contract documents.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
