A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH TRANSPORTATION STUDY AND ACKNOWLEDGING AN INTENT TO CONSIDER PROVIDING A REQUIRED MATCH FOR GRANTS AT TIME OF GRANT AWARD

- WHEREAS, a borough-wide transportation study has not been conducted since 1992 when the Borough's Comprehensive Plan was adopted by the assembly; and
- WHEREAS, many of the tasks previously identified have been completed or will be completed in the near future; and
- WHEREAS, an up-to-date transportation study will provide data that can be used to develop a transportation plan as well as assist in decision-making for capital improvement projects; and
- WHEREAS, according to the U.S. Census Bureau the Borough population has increased from 40,802 in 1990 to 49,691 in 2000; and
- WHEREAS, the population in the central region of the borough grew by 62.6%, compared to 25.8% in the southern region, 11.2% in the eastern region, and only 0.5% in the western region; and
- WHEREAS, granting agencies sometimes require either an in-kind or cash match as a condition to its grant funding;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly finds it in the best interest of the borough that a transportation study be conducted to help determine goals and objectives for a 10-year transportation plan.
- **SECTION 2.** That the assembly supports the efforts of the administration to acquire funding for the project and intends to consider an ordinance appropriating any grant funds as well as any matching requirements that may be obligatory under the grant conditions.
- SECTION 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
