**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CENTRAL PENINSULA LANDFILL
EXPANSION PROJECT AND IDENTIFYING THE PROJECT AS THE NUMBER ONE
PRIORITY SOLID WASTE MAJOR CAPITAL PROJECT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003**

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough's Central Peninsula Landfill serves approximately 75 percent of the Borough's population and must be expanded to meet long-term disposal needs; and

WHEREAS, landfill expansion requires extensive improvements to comply with state and federal regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough considers this project the number one solid waste major capital improvement project for fiscal year 2003 and has shown this commitment by appropriating funds for expansion design and placement of a bond proposition on the October 1, 2002 ballot; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough is seeking supplemental funding through various granting agencies for the propose of landfill expansion, and granting agencies sometimes require evidence of the project's local priority.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI


SECTION 2. That the Assembly supports the efforts of the administration to acquire funding for the project.
