SECTION 24. That Proposition No. 2, authorizing the sale of bonds for improvements to the regional solid waste facility near Soldotna, was approved by the voters of the borough.

SECTION 25. That Proposition No. 3, issuing up to \$14,700,000 in general obligation bonds for construction of a new middle school in Seward, was approved by the voters of the borough.

That Proposition No. 4, regarding the initiative to exempt all sales of nonprepared food items from borough sales tax, was defeated by the voters of the borough.

That Proposition No. 5, establishing a service area to exercise the powers necessary to provide a port and harbor feasibility study, was defeated by the voters in the Anchor Point Service Area.

SECTION 28. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
