RESOLUTION 2002-138**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE
KALIFORNISKY-BEACH ELEMENTARY BUS TURNAROUND PROJECT TO THE
SKYVIEW WELL HOUSE PROJECT**


- WHEREAS,** Alaska DCED Grant No. 1/98-001, was appropriated in Ordinance 2000-19-26 on June 5, 2001, identifying \$170,000 for the proposed Skyview Well House as a high priority; and
- WHEREAS,** Resolution 2002-086 increased total project funding to \$224,500; and
- WHEREAS,** this grant involved partial funding for two projects: Skyview Well House and Kalifornsky-Beach Elementary School Bus Turnaround; and
- WHEREAS,** a well house is required to meet several needs including well head protection, water hammer suppression and the present and future need for chemical treatment and storage, per ADEC and EPA regulations; and
- WHEREAS,** the post evaluation of Phase 2 bidding, shows the well house project will require \$10,000 in additional funding to complete all facets of the project for the proposed facility; and
- WHEREAS,** the K-B Elementary Bus Turnaround project is complete and has \$10,000 in account no. 400.71050.01BUS , as residual KPB funds, available for transfer; and
- WHEREAS,** transfer of \$10,000 to Skyview High School water system Project 400.71180.01WEL, would increase total project funding to \$224,500 and allow completion of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to transfer \$10,000 from account no. 400.71050.01BUS to account no. 400.71180.01WEL for a revised appropriation of \$224,500 for the Skyview Well House Project, contingent upon completion of all required grant procedural reviews by Alaska DCED.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
