**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 2002-142**

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE TRANSFER OF RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE
PLANNING, DESIGN, AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE KENAI SPUR ROAD
EXTENSION (NORTH ROAD EXTENSION)**

WHEREAS, the borough has been awarded an approximately \$6 million TEA-21 grant by the federal government for the construction of the Kenai Spur Road Extension; and

WHEREAS, design and construction of the project will be performed in phases under agreements between the borough and the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT/PF); and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Legislature appropriated \$250,000 as the borough's portion of the match for the environmental and preliminary engineering phase of the Kenai Spur Extension; and

WHEREAS, DOT/PF is working with the borough to develop a transfer of responsibility agreement for the preliminary engineering and environmental phase; and


WHEREAS, AS 35.15.080 requires a resolution of the governing body to accept the transfer of responsibility for the design, planning, and construction of the Kenai Spur Road Extension;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


SECTION 1. The Kenai Peninsula Borough requests transfer of responsibility for planning, design, and construction of improvements to the Kenai Spur Road Extension and authorizes the mayor to negotiate and execute all documents necessary to effectuate this resolution.

SECTION 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
