## A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF INCLUSION OF DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A SUBSTATION ALONG THE PROPOSED SOUTHERN INTERTIE TRANSMISSION LINE IN THE NORTH PENINSULA AREA

- WHEREAS, the Intertie Participation Group has recently received the record of decision by U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Rural Utility Service and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to construct the Southern Intertie Project; and
- WHEREAS, the permitting agencies have denied access across the Kenai National Wildlife Refuge; and
- WHEREAS, the coastal "Tesoro Pipeline" route has been identified as the chosen route; and
- WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough owns approximately 10,000 acres in the area; and
- WHEREAS, the area presently contains approximately 800 landowners who would utilize the electrical capacity of the substation; and
- WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough is in Phase One of constructing the North Road Extension in close proximity to the Intertie; and
- WHEREAS, these combined projects will ultimately lead to the growth and development of the North Peninsula area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** The Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly urges the Intertie Participants Group to include the design and construction of a substation that would serve the North Peninsula area in the overall development plan for the Southern Intertie Project.
- **SECTION 2.** That a copy of this resolution be distributed the Intertie Participants Group.
- **SECTION 3.** That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
