KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH RESOLUTION 2003-110

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SIX-MONTH EXTENSION OF AN AGREEMENT TO LOAN A TANKER PUMPER FIRE TRUCK TO NINILCHIK EMERGENCY SERVICES

- WHEREAS, on May 16, 2003, the Kenai Peninsula Borough, on behalf of the Central Emergency Service Area ("CES"), entered into an agreement with Ninilchik Emergency Services to loan a tanker pumper truck to Ninilchik Emergency Services for six months, ending October 31, 2003; and
- **WHEREAS,** the tank pumper fire truck is old but still serviceable and is normally retained by CES for emergency backup purposes; and
- WHEREAS, the Ninilchik Emergency Services department has been unable to obtain a replacement or to repair its former tanker pumper, which remains out of service; and
- WHEREAS, a fire in the area serviced by the Ninilchik Emergency Services volunteer department could easily spread into the area serviced by CES, and it is in the best interest of the borough and CES to continue the loan of this tanker pumper to Ninilchik Emergency Services, subject to immediate return in the event CES determines such return is required; and
- WHEREAS, at its meeting of September 18, 2003, the CES board unanimously approved a motion to extend the loan agreement for six months, until April 30, 2004, on the same terms and conditions as the existing loan agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the mayor is authorized to execute an extension of the Agreement Loaning Tanker Pumper Fire Truck to Ninilchik Emergency Services for a period of six months, from November 1, 2003, through April 30, 2004, subject to the remaining terms and conditions as in the original agreement.
- **SECTION 2.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
