**A RESOLUTION ALLOWING ASSEMBLY PARTICIPATION ON THE ALASKA
MUNICIPAL LEAGUE BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

WHEREAS, the Alaska Municipal League (AML) is seeking candidates for the office of 2nd Vice President ; and

WHEREAS, Assembly President Pete Sprague has expressed interest in running for this office; and

WHEREAS, the District 3 Seat on the AML Board of Directors will also be available and Assembly Member Gary Superman has indicated his willingness to serve in this capacity; and

WHEREAS, Assembly Member Betty Glick is currently serving as AML's representative to the National Association of Counties (NACo) Board of Directors and would like to seek reelection to that position; and

WHEREAS, Assembly Manual Item VI(C) provides that an assembly member seeking to be appointed or elected to a position representing the assembly on a board or committee must have assembly approval by resolution prior to seeking or accepting such a position;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the Assembly hereby authorizes Assembly President Pete Sprague to announce his candidacy for the office of 2nd Vice President of the Alaska Municipal League's Board of Directors.

SECTION 2. That the Assembly authorizes Assembly Member Gary Superman to run for the Alaska Municipal League Board of Directors representing District 3.

SECTION 3. That the Assembly further authorizes Assembly Member Betty Glick to seek reelection as the Alaska Municipal League's representative to the National Association of Counties.


SECTION 4. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
