**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF LATE-FILED SENIOR
CITIZEN EXEMPTION APPLICATIONS**

WHEREAS, the borough has received six (6) requests that the borough accept late-filed applications for the senior citizen residential real property exemption; and

WHEREAS, under Alaska Statute 29.45.030(f) the governing body for good cause shown may waive a claimant's failure to make timely application for an exemption for any year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. Upon reviewing the applications and affidavits submitted with this resolution, the assembly finds good cause for waiving the January 15 deadline for filing the Senior Citizen Exemption applications set out in Section 2 below.


SECTION 2. That the deadline for filing applications for the Senior Citizen real property exemptions, as applicable, for the following parcels is hereby waived for good cause:


SECTION 3. That the assessor shall process the applications in accordance with standard assessing department procedures for processing such applications.
