**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 2004-023**

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN ADDITIONAL PROJECTS MANAGER
POSITION IN THE CAPITAL PROJECTS DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, work must begin immediately to provide staffing for all field work due on the numerous small and large projects scheduled for completion over the next two years; and

WHEREAS, those projects totaling approximately \$87.7 million will immediately and significantly increase the workload; and

WHEREAS, earthwork portions of the \$49.9M Central Peninsula General Hospital and the \$17M South Peninsula Hospital projects, which were passed on ballot issues within this current fiscal year, along with the \$14.7M Seward Middle School project, will start this spring and will require specific daily field inspection; and

WHEREAS, field inspection activities for the Seward Middle School project are to start by early March; and

WHEREAS, funds are available in account no. 401.75030.03SEW;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That an additional major capital projects manager position is authorized in the Capital Projects Department.

SECTION 2. That all expenditures for this project will be charged to account no. 401.75030.03SEW.

SECTION 3. That it is anticipated that the project manager will be needed for a period of approximately three years, with time dedicated to the capital projects listed. The position will be deleted when the projects are completed and appropriated monies are spent.


SECTION 4. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
