RESOLUTION 2004-094**

**A RESOLUTION URGING THE ALASKA STATE BOARD OF FISHERIES TO
PROVIDE PUBLIC OPPORTUNITY FOR TESTIMONY IN SOLDOTNA
AT ITS UPCOMING JANUARY MEETING**

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Board of Fisheries is scheduled to meet January 17-29, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the meeting's agenda will pertain specifically to upper Cook Inlet finfish; and

WHEREAS, a majority of issues likely to be discussed can potentially impact local commercial, personal use and sports fishermen; and

WHEREAS, accessibility and availability of the Board to take comments from peninsula residents in the Kenai-Soldotna area is not only desirable, but reinforces faith in, and maximizes credibility of, the public process;

NOW, THEREFORE , BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH;


SECTION 1. That Alaska State Board of Fisheries is strongly encouraged to take public comment in Soldotna during the weekend of January 22-23, 2005, either by scheduled appearance or through provision of videoconferencing availability.

SECTION 2. That the Alaska State Board of Fisheries is strongly encouraged to hold committee meeting in the Kenai/Soldotna area concerning Kenai River sockeye, kings and coho.


