**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING USE OF THE STERLING COMMUNITY PLAN AS A
TOOL IN THE BOROUGH'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN PROCESS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to AS 29.40.030 the comprehensive plan is required to be updated periodically; and

WHEREAS, the comprehensive plan by its terms requires periodic review and update; and

WHEREAS, the 1992 comprehensive plan is undergoing a public hearing and update process; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 1, Goal 1-1, Objective 2 of the comprehensive plan is to assist community organizations in developing community plans and obtaining funding for needed community services and facilities; and

WHEREAS, a number of communities have or are in the process of developing community plans through a grant to the Kenai Peninsula Borough Economic Development District, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, identifying projects within community plans assists the community in establishing goals and assists them in obtaining grant funds for the projects; and

WHEREAS, there is useful information and guidance in the Sterling Community Plan that may be appropriate for incorporation in the borough's comprehensive plan; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission discussed this resolution at its October 11, 2004 meeting and recommended adoption by a majority vote;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:**


