**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 2004-117**

**A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THAT THE COASTAL ZONE MANAGER
POSITION SHALL REMAIN VACANT UNTIL THE FY 2006 BUDGET IS APPROVED**

WHEREAS, the Coastal Zone Program continues to have uncertainty at the state level with respect to both the future of the program and the availability of grant funding that has steadily decreased from 90% to the current 50% of our Coastal Zone Manager position; and

WHEREAS, state grant funding for the Coastal Zone Manager position has steadily decreased from 90% of the position to the current funding level of 50%; and

WHEREAS, the borough is about to begin the fiscal year 2006 budget process; and

WHEREAS, the assembly defeated Ordinance 2004-19-15, Appropriating Funds for a ¾ Time Senior Clerk Typist Position for the Coastal Management Program; and

WHEREAS, the Coastal Zone Manager Position is currently vacant and it is appropriate to not fill the position with the current budgetary and regulatory uncertainties, and the possibility the assembly may choose not to fund the position in the FY 2006 budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. The Coastal Zone Manager position shall remain vacant until the FY 2006 years budget is approved.

SECTION 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.
