**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 2005-005**

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT AND RESCUE
EQUIPMENT FROM THE SOUTHERN REGION EMERGENCY MEDICAL
SERVICES COUNCIL, INC., ON BEHALF OF BEAR CREEK FIRE SERVICE AREA**

WHEREAS, the Borough's Office of Emergency Management has developed a comprehensive plan for upgrading its communications throughout the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the plan identifies as a number one priority the need for a borough-wide Interoperable Communications System; and

WHEREAS, Bear Creek Fire Service Area ("BCFSA") submitted an application to the Southern Region Emergency Medical Services Council, Inc. ("Southern Region"), for communications equipment and rescue equipment at a total cost of \$58,106; and

WHEREAS, the Southern Region notified BCFSA that its request for equipment has been approved; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska funding will pay for 90 percent of the equipment, and the remaining 10 percent must be paid by a local match from BCFSA; and

WHEREAS, the Southern Region will purchase the equipment and provide it to BCFSA upon receipt of the 10 percent matching funds; and

WHEREAS, matching funds are currently available in the amount of \$5,811 for this purpose in the approved FY05 BCFSA operating budget; and

WHEREAS, at its regularly scheduled meeting held December 14, 2004, the BCFSA Board recommended acceptance of the grant and the expenditure of the matching funds; and


WHEREAS, the equipment requested by BCFSA is an integral part of the Borough's overall communications plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept rescue equipment and communications equipment valued at \$58,106 from the Southern Region Emergency Medical Services Council, Inc., on behalf of the Bear Creek Fire Service Area.


SECTION 2. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
