RESOLUTION 2005-025**

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE MAYOR SPEND UP TO \$6,000 TO HIRE AN
INDEPENDENT CONSULTANT TO PERFORM A FUNCTIONAL, SOCIAL, AND
ECONOMIC AUDIT OF CARTS, CEDD, EDD, AND GENERAL SERVICES
PRINT/MAIL**

WHEREAS, there is a continual public clamor for lean government; and

WHEREAS, the public is most curious to understand costs and benefits associated with
CARTS, CEDD, EDD, and General Services Print/Mail; and

WHEREAS, in assessing potentially contentious issues it often is beneficial to engage an
impartial evaluator;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

SECTION 1. That the mayor is requested to hire an independent consultant/evaluator at a cost
up to \$6000 to perform a functional, social, and economic audit of CARTS,
CEDD, EDD, and General Services Print/Mail. For each of these departments or
organizations, the consultant evaluator should produce a short report indicating
direct and indirect short-term and long-term associated costs and benefits to the
borough and the public. The report also should succinctly indicate costs and
benefits associated with eliminating the borough's support for these
organizations, or, as appropriate, outsourcing those services to the private sector.

SECTION 2. That \$6,000 shall be transferred from assembly account 100.11110.43210
transportation and subsistence to 100.11110.43011 contract services.

SECTION 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
