SUBJECT: Resolution 2005-67, Kachemak Emergency Service Area agreement

Attached for your review is the agreement reached between the City of Homer, Kachemak Emergency Service Area Board and the borough administration. This agreement includes an eighteen month term, which will cause future agreements to coincide with the budget cycle for the City of Homer, simplifying both parties' ability to predict expenses. This agreement represents over six months' efforts by both KESA and the City of Homer, and includes significantly more detail than did earlier agreements. The agreed upon dollar amount is a compromise; the parties hope to agree upon a formula to determine the cost of future agreements.

Please amend the resolution as follows:

Amend the fourth Whereas clause as follows:

WHEREAS, at its meeting of October 27, 2005, the Kachemak Emergency Service Area board recommended that the assembly approve entering the negotiated agreement; and

Amend Section 1 as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The mayor is authorized to execute the accompanying Agreement for Provision of Fire and Emergency Medical Services attached hereto and incorporated by reference as Attachment A. In this agreement the City of Homer will provide fire and emergency medical services for [THREE YEARS] eighteen months for the sum of \$182,136 for the first year, and the sum of \$101,819, for a total price of \$283,955. [ADJUSTED FOR THE REMAINING TWO YEARS AS FOLLOWS: 101,819 ———. The agreement shall be retroactively effective on July 1, 2005.
