A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING A TRAAK GRANT APPLICATION FOR JACOBS LADDER DRIVE IN THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

- WHEREAS, Jacobs Ladder Drive is a 1800' platted borough right-of-way within the Gray Cliff Subdivision that provides direct access from the beach to the un-constructed North Kenai Road Extension right-of-way; and
- WHEREAS, Jacobs Ladder Drive provides access to approximately 800 parcels in the Moose Point and Gray Cliff Subdivision and 8,000 acres of borough land in the Point Possession area; and
- WHEREAS, Jacobs Ladder Drive provides public access for all-terrain vehicles (ATV's) and snow machines by residents, surveyors, hunters, fishermen and government.
- WHEREAS, the deterioration in the right-of-way has left the trail access impassible, causing trespassing across private property to access the North Kenai Road Extension right-of-way, pipeline corridor, utility corridor and subdivisions in that area.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ROAD SERVICE AREA:

- SECTION 1. The RSA Board supports the TRAAK grant application for the Jacobs Ladder Drive Trail Improvement.
- SECTION 2. The RSA Board supports the addition of private and other alternate funding to accomplish this project.
- SECTION 3. That a copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to the mayor and the assembly
