**SUBJECT:** Resolution 2005-106, opposing the Alaska DEC proposal to allow increased mixing zones

Upon further reviewing this resolution, I propose the following amendments to clarify what was meant by the term "alternative proposal" in the title:

- Amend the title as follows:

A RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION'S PROPOSAL TO ALLOW INCREASED MIXING ZONES IN SPAWNING AREAS AND SUPPORTING AN ALTERNATIVE PROPOSAL AS SUPPORTED BY THE CITY OF SOLDOTNA IN ITS RESOLUTION 2005-074

- Amend Section 1 as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly opposes the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation's proposal to allow increased mixing zones in spawning areas[, EXCEPT]. However, it supports the alternative proposal submitted by the City of Soldotna in its Resolution 2005-074, which allows for the renewal of mixing zone permits [FOR] in areas [WITH] for which mixing zone permits have already been issued and where spawning beds have developed after issuance of the initial permit.
