Upon further reviewing this resolution, I propose the following amendments to clarify what was meant by the term "alternative proposal" in the title:

Amend the title as follows:

A RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION'S PROPOSAL TO ALLOW INCREASED MIXING ZONES IN SPAWNING AREAS AND SUPPORTING AN ALTERNATIVE PROPOSAL <u>AS</u> SUPPORTED BY THE CITY OF SOLDOTNA IN ITS RESOLUTION 2005-074

Amend Section 1 as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly opposes the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation's proposal to allow increased mixing zones in spawning areas[, EXCEPT]. However, it supports the alternative proposal submitted by the City of Soldotna in its Resolution 2005-074, which allows for the renewal of mixing zone permits [FOR] in areas [WITH] for which mixing zone permits have already been issued and where spawning beds have developed after issuance of the initial permit.
