- Plan 1: The "least change" plan. 4 districts, as is currently in place, 16 assembly members, number of members per district varies from 2 to 4 each. See Map A below.
- Plan 2: 16 single member districts. See Map B below.
- Plan 3: 11 single member districts. See Map C below.
- Plan 4: 8 districts, 2 members each. See Map D below.
- Plan 5: 3 districts, with boundaries to follow state House districts, 5 members each. See Map E below.
- Plan 6: 3 districts, with boundaries to follow state House districts; 5 subdistricts in each district that members must reside in, but otherwise at large elections in each of the 3 districts. See Map F below.
- Plan 7: 3 districts, with boundaries to follow state House districts, 5 subdistricts in each district (15 single member districts). See Map F below.
- Plan 8: 3 districts, with boundaries to follow state House districts, 3 members each. See Map E below.
- Plan 9: 3 districts, with boundaries to follow state House districts, 3 subdistricts in each district that members must reside in, but otherwise at large elections in each of the 3 districts. See Map G below.
- Plan 10: 3 districts, with boundaries to follow state House districts, 3 subdistricts in each district (9 single member districts). See Map G below.
