KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2000-09

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$400,000 FROM THE ROAD SERVICE AREA FUND BALANCE FOR THE ROAD SERVICE AREA

- WHEREAS, state revenue sharing for roads has declined from \$2,500 per mile in 1981 to \$416 per mile in 2000, with state legislators currently deliberating further significant cuts to state revenue sharing for fiscal year 2001; and
- WHEREAS, snowfall this year has resulted in expenditures beyond the amount budgeted for snow removal in the FY-2000 budget, and the road service area has a fund balance of approximately \$464,000; and
- WHEREAS, road maintenance is a high priority for the borough;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. The sum of \$400,000 shall be transferred from the road service area fund balance and appropriated to the road service area road maintenance account No. 236.33950.00000.46910 to provide supplemental funding for essential road maintenance services.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
