KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2000-14

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$671,792 FROM THE BOROUGH GENERAL FUND BALANCE TO THE SCHOOL FUND FOR OUTSIDE THE CAP FUNDING OF YEAR ONE OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM

- WHEREAS, in April of 1999, the assembly president appointed a School Technology Working Group to review the school district's plan to expand the use of technological resources; and
- WHEREAS, the committee completed its review and presented an updated school district six-year technology plan to the school board and the assembly in November and December of 1999; and
- WHEREAS, the total cost of the six-year plan is estimated at approximately \$12 million with funding provided from several sources including the school district operating budget, the school district Connections program, the Federal E-rate program and outside-thecap funding from the borough; and
- WHEREAS, the borough funding consists of a total of \$1,595,908 in limited term outside-the-cap funding to be contributed over the first three years of the plan with the program projected to be sustained from other sources beginning in year four; and
- WHEREAS, the borough funding consists of \$671,792 in the first year, \$442,448 in the second year and \$481,668 in the third year; and
- WHEREAS, the first year borough funding of \$671,792 needs to be appropriated by the end of April 2000 in order to support implementation of the plan during the FY2001 school year; and
- WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available in the general fund balance to support this appropriation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH THAT:

- **SECTION 1.** That subject to the provisions of this ordinance, \$671,792 is appropriated from the borough general fund balance to the school special revenue fund.
- **SECTION 2.** That disbursements from the appropriation in Section 1 shall be made directly to the school district capital improvement fund to support the purchase of personal computers, software and related equipment.
- SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
