**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2000-19-09**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF HABITAT PROTECTION
FUNDS TO THE KENAI RIVER CENTER FUND**

WHEREAS, In 1995 the Borough sponsored a community reception for Senator Ted Stevens as part of the Kenai River Classic; and

WHEREAS, funding for the reception was received through corporate donations, ticket sales and sponsor funds; and

WHEREAS, the funds received exceeded the cost of the reception in the amount of \$1,660.38; and

WHEREAS, one purpose of the reception was to raise funds for preservation of salmon habitat along the Kenai River, which is achieved through construction projects and a public awareness campaign; and


WHEREAS, one goal of the Kenai River Center is to provide public awareness of the need for habitat protection along the Kenai River;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


SECTION 1. That the proceeds from the reception in the amount of \$1,660.38 shall be transferred and appropriated to the Kenai River Center Fund for the purpose of providing educational materials on the need for habitat protection along the Kenai River.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
