KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2000-19-25

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$2,000 FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF SIX INDIVIDUALS FROM REMOTE BOROUGH LOCATIONS TO ATTEND A SCHOOL BOARD AND ASSEMBLY MEETING

- WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough includes schools located at Nanwalek, Port Graham, Seldovia, and Tyonek which are not accessible by road; and
- WHEREAS, enabling a student representative from each school and two adult chaperons to attend a school board meeting and borough assembly meeting in Soldotna would have great educational value, and would promote better communications between the school board, the assembly, and these communities; and
- WHEREAS, a supplemental appropriation of \$2,000 is sufficient to fund the travel expenses for six individuals from these two communities to travel to and from Kenai and attend a school board meeting and an assembly meeting;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the sum of \$2,000 shall be transferred from assembly account 100.11110.00000.49999 to 100.94910.00000.47241 and appropriated to school district fund account 241.94910.00000.47241 for the purpose of providing a grant to the school district. This grant shall be used to fund round-trip transportation of four students, one each from Nanwalek, Port Graham, Seldovia, and Tyonek, and two adult chaperons, to Kenai to fund lodging and meals for three days and two nights.
- **SECTION 2.** That the school district shall establish criteria for selecting the appropriate students and chaperons for this trip.
- **SECTION 3.** That the mayor is authorized to negotiate and execute any documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this ordinance.
- **SECTION 4.** That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
