KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2000-19-29

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$200,000 FROM THE ROAD SERVICE AREA FUND BALANCE FOR THE ROAD SERVICE AREA

- WHEREAS, severe icing conditions required extensive sanding and grader serration services in the winter of 2000-01; and
- WHEREAS, to the extent possible, the road service area (RSA) transferred funds from other line items to pay increased winter maintenance bills; and
- WHEREAS, the RSA board adopted a resolution at its April 10, 2001 meeting supporting a transfer of \$200,000 from the RSA fund balance to address the need for additional funding; and
- WHEREAS, there is a projected fund balance for FY 2001 of \$857,438; and
- WHEREAS, the transfer from RSA fund balance is necessary to pay outstanding RSA obligations; and
- WHEREAS, the increased mill levy for the road service area in FY-01 was primarily dedicated to capital improvement projects and fund balance, not road maintenance; and
- WHEREAS, road maintenance is a high priority for the borough;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** The sum of \$200,000 shall be transferred from the road service area fund balance and appropriated to the road service area road maintenance account No. 236.33950.00000.46910 to provide supplemental funding for essential road maintenance services.
- **SECTION 2.** That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
