KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2000-19-30

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$95,983 FROM THE LAND TRUST FUND BALANCE FOR FURTHER SITE ASSESSMENT, GROUNDWATER SAMPLING, AND EXCAVATION OF HYDROCARBON-IMPACTED SOILS AT THE NANWALEK ELEMENTARY/HIGH SCHOOL

- WHEREAS, the Borough Maintenance Department found hydrocarbon-impacted soils at the Nanwalek Elementary/High School playground during routine maintenance work in the summer of 2000; and
- WHEREAS, records research revealed spill(s) from an above-ground storage tank may have occurred on the property in late 1979 and/or early 1980; and
- WHEREAS, site assessment work conducted in the fall of 2000 revealed groundwater levels of diesel range organics were above those allowable by Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation regulations; and
- WHEREAS, the Borough is required to perform cleanup actions to remediate the groundwater levels, including excavation of hydrocarbon-impacted soils and further assessment at four locations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That \$95,983 is appropriated from the Land Trust Fund Balance to account 250.21210.01NAN.49999 for further site assessment, groundwater sampling, and removal of hydrocarbon-impacted soils at the Nanwalek Elementary/High School.
- **SECTION 2.** That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
