**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2000-26**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$197,593.84 TO BE RECEIVED FROM THE
DIVISION OF EMERGENCY SERVICES TO REIMBURSE THE BOROUGH FOR
COSTS INCURRED IN RESPONDING TO THE SEVERE WINTER STORMS
OCCURRING FROM DECEMBER 21, 1999 TO FEBRUARY 23, 2000.**

WHEREAS, the Borough was hit by a number of winter storms between the dates of December 21, 1999 to February 23, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Borough incurred substantial costs due to these winter storms; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works department incurred administrative costs in responding to the severe winter storms; and

WHEREAS, the Insurance and Litigation Fund incurred claims due to the severe winter storms; and

WHEREAS, various Borough facilities were damaged as a result of the storm; and

WHEREAS, the Bear Creek Fire Service Area incurred damage to their facility due to the severe winter storm; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough general government incurred administrative costs in requesting, obtaining and administering federal disaster assistance; and

WHEREAS, a disaster was declared by the Borough Mayor on February 3, 2000, by the State of Alaska on February 4, 2000 and amended on February 8, 2000 to include the Kenai Peninsula Borough and signed by the President on February 17, 2000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That \$2,730.50 for costs incurred by Public Works department in response to these storms be appropriated to the Disaster Relief Fund and to the Public Works Department. An intergovernmental charge from the Public Works department will be made to the Disaster Relief Fund to transfer these costs.

SECTION 2. That \$86,916.18 for claims incurred by the Insurance and Litigation Fund in response to these storms be appropriated to the Disaster Relief Fund and to the Insurance and Litigation Fund. An intergovernmental charge from the Insurance and Litigation Fund will be made to the Disaster Relief Fund to transfer these costs.

SECTION 3. That \$90,704.99 for damage to Borough facilities be appropriated to the Capital Projects Fund and to the Disaster Relief Fund. Capital appropriations for storm related damage are as follows: Hope School, \$12,250.00; K-Beach Elementary, \$20,910; Soldotna Elementary School, \$3,871.00; Soldotna High School, \$4,798.00; Nikiski Elementary School, \$4,171.00; Kenai Central High School, \$42,874.99; Tustamena Elementary School, \$1,098.00; and Seward High School, \$732.00. An interfund transfer from the Disaster Relief Fund will be made to the Capital Project Fund to fund these projects.


SECTION 4. That \$1,615.24 for costs incurred by the Bear Creek Service Area in response to these storms be appropriated to the Disaster Relief Fund and to the Bear Creek Service Area Fund. An intergovernmental charge from the Bear Creek Service Area will be made to the Disaster Relief Fund to transfer these costs.

SECTION 5. That \$15,626.93 for costs incurred by the General Fund in response to these storms be appropriated to the Disaster Relief Fund and to the General Fund. An intergovernmental charge from the General Fund will be made to the Disaster Relief Fund to transfer these costs.


SECTION 6. That the appropriations are made to the FY2000 budget.

SECTION 7. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
