KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2000-60

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO HIRE A LEGISLATIVE LIAISON TO REPRESENT THE BOROUGH'S INTERESTS IN PENDING STATE LEGISLATION AND APPROPRIATING \$20,000 TO THE MAYOR'S BUDGET

- WHEREAS, legislation will soon be considered by the state legislature that, if enacted, could significantly affect borough expenditures for school district operations and road maintenance, in addition to such projects as the private prison and the gas pipeline; and
- WHEREAS, these decisions could impact taxpayers in the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and
- WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to contract with a legislative liaison to protect the borough's interests in these issues;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the mayor is authorized to waive formal bidding procedures and hire a legislative liaison to lobby on behalf of the Kenai Peninsula Borough's interests regarding state legislation affecting education funding, road maintenance programs, private prison, the gas pipeline project and other legislation.
- **SECTION 2.** That the sum of \$20,000 is appropriated from the General Fund Balance to Account Number 100.11210.LOBBY.43011 to be used for hiring a lobbyist as authorized in this ordinance.
- **SECTION 3.** That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
