
**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE FRAMEWORK FOR
WATER QUALITY MONITORING OF THE KENAI RIVER**

- WHEREAS,** the residents of the Kenai Peninsula Borough are aware of the central role that the Kenai River has had in the history, growth, and development of the region; and
- WHEREAS,** the health and vitality of the Kenai River will be a major concern as the area continues to grow and develop; and
- WHEREAS,** water quality data can serve as a key indicator of the health of the Kenai River; and
- WHEREAS,** there are benefits in coordinating efforts for the planning, collection, analysis, management, and presentation of baseline water quality data; and
- WHEREAS,** a wide variety of agencies and organizations including the City of Soldotna, the City of Kenai, the Alaska Department of Fish and Game, and the Kenai River Special Management Area Board have agreed to support the Framework.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


- SECTION 1:** That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly supports the current Framework for Water Quality Monitoring of the Kenai River as prepared by the Nature Conservancy of Alaska in November 1998;
- SECTION 2:** That this agreement does not obligate the borough in the expenditure of funds, contributions to monitoring, or providing staff support.
- SECTION 3.** That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
