A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE COOPER LANDING SENIOR CITIZEN CORPORATION, INC. AS AN ORGANIZATION ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE BOROUGH'S SENIOR CITIZEN GRANT PROGRAM


- WHEREAS,** the Cooper Landing Senior Citizen Corporation, Inc. has received a Certificate of Incorporation as a nonprofit corporation in the State of Alaska; and
- WHEREAS,** the Cooper Landing Senior Citizen Corporation, Inc. has been classified as a 501(C)(3) tax exempt corporation by the U.S. Internal Revenue Service and is located in the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and
- WHEREAS,** KPB Chapter 5.22 provides funding for senior citizen organizations meeting certain conditions; and
- WHEREAS,** many senior citizens in Cooper Landing are unable to take advantage of the senior services offered in Seward and Sterling because of the long distance involved; and
- WHEREAS,** the Cooper Landing Senior Citizen Corporation, Inc. seeks recognition by the Assembly to become eligible to receive senior citizen program funding from the Borough;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:



That pursuant to KPB 5.22.020(B) the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly recognizes the Cooper Landing Senior Citizen Corporation, Inc., as a senior citizens organization eligible to participate in the senior citizen grant program of the Kenai Peninsula Borough under Chapter 5.22 of the Borough Code.

SECTION 2. This resolution becomes effective upon its adoption.
