**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
RESOLUTION 2000-023**

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR TO WITHDRAW HIS  
NOMINATIONS TO THE NORTH PACIFIC FISHERIES  
MANAGEMENT COUNCIL UNTIL THE PROCESS SET FORTH IN  
THE MAGNUSON-STEVENS ACT IS FOLLOWED**

**WHEREAS,** the Magnuson-Stevens Act provides, in part, that the Governor must, to the extent practicable, consult with representatives of the commercial and recreational fishing interests of the State prior to submitting his list of nominees for the North Pacific Fisheries Management Council; and

**WHEREAS,** Governor Knowles recently nominated individuals to serve on this Council without first consulting with representatives of the commercial fishing industry; and

**WHEREAS,** it is in the best interest of the State that representation on the Council be balanced and that those individuals nominated to the Council have the support of both the commercial and sport fishing industries;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

**SECTION 1.** That Governor Knowles is urged to withdraw his nominations to the North Pacific Fisheries Management Council.

**SECTION 2.** That Governor Knowles is further urged to consult with representatives of both the commercial and sports fishing industries prior to making future nominations to the North Pacific Fisheries Management Council.

**SECTION 3.** That a copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to Governor Tony Knowles.

**SECTION 4.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
