**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
RESOLUTION 2000-061**

**AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES  
AND PROPRIETY TECHNOLOGY FOR THE REPAIR AND UPGRADE OF THE  
WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM AT MCNEIL CANYON ELEMENTARY  
SCHOOL**

**WHEREAS,** the existing wastewater treatment system at McNeil Canyon Elementary School currently does not perform to design standards; and

**WHEREAS,** remedying the deficiencies in the wastewater treatment system at McNeil Canyon Elementary School is of the utmost importance; and

**WHEREAS,** the BioCycle wastewater treatment unit is an existing propriety technology which can be utilized at the McNeil Canyon Elementary School; and

**WHEREAS,** the sole proprietor for this technology in Alaska is BioCycle, Alaska, located in the Kenai area; and

**WHEREAS,** the proprietor of this technology is also a registered design professional, familiar with the design and installation of wastewater treatment systems utilizing this technology; and

**WHEREAS,** Section 5.28.280 of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances provides for sole-source procurement where it is determined by the purchasing officer or agency head that the borough's requirements reasonably limit the procurement to a sole source; and

**WHEREAS,** funds are available from the capital improvement budget for these services;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**


**SECTION 1.** That the mayor is authorized to award a contract to BioCycle, Alaska to perform design services and supply wastewater treatment units for the proposed amount of \$35,200.

**SECTION 2.** That all expenditures for this project will be charged to account number 400-71060-01708.

**SECTION 3.** That the mayor is authorized to execute all documents and make all agreements deemed necessary to complete this project in accordance with this resolution and contract documents.


**SECTION 4.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
