AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AND PROPRIETY TECHNOLOGY FOR THE REPAIR AND UPGRADE OF THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM AT MCNEIL CANYON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

- WHEREAS, the existing wastewater treatment system at McNeil Canyon Elementary School currently does not perform to design standards; and
- WHEREAS, remedying the deficiencies in the wastewater treatment system at McNeil Canyon Elementary School is of the utmost importance; and
- WHEREAS, the BioCycle wastewater treatment unit is an existing propriety technology which can be utilized at the McNeil Canyon Elementary School; and
- WHEREAS, the sole proprietor for this technology in Alaska is BioCycle, Alaska, located in the Kenai area; and
- WHEREAS, the proprietor of this technology is also a registered design professional, familiar with the design and installation of wastewater treatment systems utilizing this technology; and
- WHEREAS, Section 5.28.280 of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances provides for sole-source procurement where it is determined by the purchasing officer or agency head that the borough's requirements reasonably limit the procurement to a sole source; and
- WHEREAS, funds are available from the capital improvement budget for these services;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the mayor is authorized to award a contract to BioCycle, Alaska to perform design services and supply wastewater treatment units for the proposed amount of \$35,200.
- SECTION 2. That all expenditures for this project will be charged to account number 400-71060-01708.

SECTION 3. That the mayor is authorized to execute all documents and make all agreements deemed necessary to complete this project in accordance with this resolution and contract documents.
