## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH RESOLUTION 2000-065

## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CENTRAL PENINSULA GENERAL HOSPITAL, INC. TO ESTABLISH A SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROGRAM

- WHEREAS, Section 21 of the Central Peninsula General Hospital Lease and Operating Agreement requires that the lessee/operator obtain approval from the borough prior to establishing a new service with expenditures in excess of \$100,000; and
- WHEREAS, Central Peninsula General Hospital, Inc. (CPGH, Inc.) wishes to establish and operate a 24-hour chemical dependency program; and
- WHEREAS, CPGH, Inc. administration projects a \$141,000 loss during the first year of operation of this service; and
- WHEREAS, CPGH, Inc. recognizes that this service is a community need that is currently not being met; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of CPGH, Inc. at their meeting of June 29, 2000 approved Resolution 00-06 authorizing the establishment of a substance abuse program; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Central Peninsula Hospital Service Area Board approved the establishment of a substance abuse program at their July 19, 2000 meeting; and
- WHEREAS, the CPGH, Inc. administration recommends leasing a four to six bed residential unit for the purpose of providing chemical dependency residential treatment services; and
- WHEREAS, the Behavioral Medicine Committee, a committee composed of medical professionals and community members, to implement this program, recommends establishment of this program;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the assembly approves the establishment and operation of a substance abuse program with associated projected expenditures in excess of \$100,000, by CPGH, Inc., pursuant to Section 21(b) of the Lease and Operating Agreement.
- **SECTION 2.** That this resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.
